### NO WOOD ALLOWED:

No camper, including seasonal, will be allowed to bring firewood into Brialee per a state of Connecticut mandate!! (see reason for the mandate below) please understand the severity of this matter and imagine what would happen to Brialee if we became infested by these beetles and were forced to cut all our trees. Brialee is a family business passed down in generations, losing our trees would all but destroy our business and your family camping experience. You must purchase wood from Brialee. You cannot purchase wood from local vendors. If you do bring wood in, you will be forced to return the wood to your home and then return to Brialee. We apologize for the inconvenience. We hope you understand the severity of this matter. This is a temporary mandate, you will be advised when the situation changes. In an effort to help, Brialee has reduced its bundled wood rate to \$5 for one, \$9 for two, and \$12 for three and will have bulk wood available in the very near future, ask for details, if you would like to buy more than bundled wood. Any long term campers can purchase a cord of wood through Brialee office for \$195. Thank you.
