### About Olympic Teams & Competitions

<p><b>All teams must be rostered by 10am on Saturday morning. No substitutions will be allowed.</b></p> <p>Your team may only attend one event at a time – you may not double dip by attending multiple.</p>	<p><b>6 maximum per team.</b> Not all 6 need to participate at each event – but these will be the only ones allowed to score points for the team.</p>	<p><b>Any camper can participate in any event,</b> regardless of participation in the Olympics for Points. These activities are not restricted only to Olympic Teams. However, there may be extra runs of the activity that are restricted only to Olympians.</p>
<p><b>Olympic Score Board</b> will be posted at the front of the office beside the Blackboard. Please do not change or alter points board. If there are any discrepancies – please see Olympic Event Manager with issues.</p>	<p><b>Teams participate in events as they choose.</b> Each event will be issued points to winners, as well as participation points. If you don't participate – you won't win. You may only get points in one event per hour.</p>	<p><b>There are games that are designed for the athletically-challenged, so you don't need to be super athletic to participate.</b> Join in on one of the silly or athletically-challenged Olympic Games.</p>
<p><b>Friday Night - Break Into Teams</b> You'll need at least four people for each Olympic teams, but more is better. (Roster has to be submitted Saturday morning by 10am – no late entries or substitutes allowed).</p>	<p><b>Friday Night - Choose Your Country</b> Your group will choose a country to represent (it can be made up); make up a flag, choose a mascot, song, or cheer, decorate your shirts (uniforms), and decorate paper flags.</p>	<p><b>Opening Ceremony &amp; Torch Ceremony (start Friday at 7)</b> Teams will parade from beach to new rec hall, where teams will be introduced and torch will be celebrated.</p>
<p><b>Rain or Shine</b> all Olympic games will take place, regardless of weather. We have chosen games that can be played inside or outside.
