Campers Carnival – Helpful Hints...

Campers Carnival is a fun, old-fashioned style carnival where the campers make the booths, and keep all the money they make. Campers come up with ideas for carnival-style games, like balloon popping, knocking down cans, fishing, and more. **Get creative!** Find some things to give as prizes if you want to. Make a sign. Charge a nominal fee to play (if you want – or let campers play for free!). The idea is to have as many different kinds of booths/games as possible so our camper families can come down and enjoy the carnival and have a good time. **Have more questions? Come to a Q&A Session Saturday at 10 – Rec Hall.**

Important Reminders:

- You can NOT set up or reserve space (in any way) until the set-up time scheduled. Staff may request that you move, based on demand or other spacing requirements.
- Booths MAY NOT be set up under the pavilion, courts, or on the paved surfaces going down to or at the rec hall – these spaces MUST be kept clear for traffic / safety. This includes tables trying to be set up beneath the roof line for shade. The entire paved area will be kept clear and picnic tables may not be used for carnival booths. You must supply your own tables/chairs, items needed to conduct your booth.
- Power is limited – please try to choose a game that does not require power. If you DO need power – please say so on the sign up sheet at the office (by 11 Saturday).
- Booths must be set up from beginning until end of carnival, and must be manned throughout the carnival, so please plan appropriately so your child can also enjoy the other games & events going on.
- **You may NOT drive your vehicle down in to the game field to unload.** All unloading MUST be done behind the rec hall, with items carried from there to the game field (grassy area between rec hall and office). Cars may NOT be left behind rec hall or in front of store during carnival. Visitor parking lot may be used, if space is available. **This includes golf carts and is strictly enforced!**
- This is not intended on being a tag sale. Your booth should be something to do – a game, event, raffle, food, craft, or something else carnival-like. Site to Site tag sales are taking place – please sell at your site.
- The cheaper your game is – the more campers will be able to play! Less is More\$...
- Be creative – come up with an idea that hasn't been done before. Keep it simple and easy to do for all ages. The more enjoyable your game – the more returns you'll have!
- There is NO jumping in the pool to clean off if your booth is something that is getting you messy! For instance, if your booth gets you tie dyed or covered in egg, you are not allowed to run back and forth to the pool to "clean off" from the booth mess. There are showers in the bathrooms that may be used for this.
- You are responsible for setting up AND removing your booth from the game field – including all garbage and/or mess created. No dumping of water or other items in the Game Field (without permission from staff). You must provide all necessary equipment to conduct your booth (including tables, cords, etc.) We do not provide any of this, and even picnic tables are not available for booth use (we have services using those tables and they are for campers to eat/sit at to enjoy the event). Thank you for understanding!
- Please make sure to register your booth at office prior to 11am and see a staff member upon move in at the game field to sign in. You may not take any space until you have done this. Your items will be moved if you have not registered.
- Have Fun! Help make the Campers Carnival a GREAT event for all!
